



OXFORD HOUSES OF COLORADO

Department of Corrections and Re-Entry

All three phases start with a custom application, will require a pre-screen interview and, will be housing voucher eligible predicated on pre-approval from CRES.

PHASE 1

This individual is treated like any other potential member in that they will be eligible for any house with vacancies, pay regular amount of EES and, provide the standard \$250 move-in deposit.

PHASE 2

This individual has a special exception due to; limited financial resources and community support. Phase two allows for a qualifying individual to move into a designated DOC room, without deposit, and with a weekly EES of \$50 a week for a maximum of 60 day's from move in.

This individual then has this 60-day period to find employment and save money to move into a regular Oxford House room or to a parole approved location. This individual will be receiving weekly vouchers for (4) weeks which will be held in a DOC payee account till the 60-day maximum or before.

PHASE 3

This individual is qualified for phase 3 due to emergency circumstances like: no regular or DOC beds available, homelessness, or transitioning from a detox facility. Certain houses have an overflow bed that can accommodate these individuals on a short-term basis. There is no set EES amount to be paid and the amount, if any, is determined by the house.
